**Special Disposal Rate Offer
for Atlantic Compact Generators
for Registered Waste generated prior to May 1, 2008**

This special disposal rate offer is available to Waste Generators located in the Atlantic Compact region who agree to the terms and conditions set forth herein, and submit a form registering Applicable Waste that was generated prior to May 1, 2008.

Applicable Waste

Applicable Waste is waste disposed at Barnwell on July 1, 2008, or after, but which was generated prior to May 1, 2008, for which an approved Registration Form has been signed and submitted to the Chem-Nuclear Prior Notification and Planning Office within 60 days of generation of the waste. Waste may be registered 60 days or more after its generation at South Carolina's option. Waste that is "generated" is defined generally as material that is removed and isolated from other materials for purposes of disposal. The date that the waste is generated is generally the date that the waste is removed from its initial collection point and moved into a location whose purpose is the consolidation of waste for storage prior to shipment for disposal or for treatment prior to disposal. This location may be, for example, a closet, a room, a separate building, or a specific area within a room, or a storage facility off-site.

Disposal Rate

The disposal rate for all waste registered as Applicable Waste is 75 percent of the disposal rate that would be assessed for that waste, if the waste had been disposed in Fiscal Year 2007, under the FY2007 rate schedule or contract rate that would otherwise be applicable to the waste.

Option B Commitment Customers

Waste generators who have submitted Option B Volume Commitments for Fiscal Year 2007 may revise and re-submit those Volume Commitments to South Carolina not later than September 30, 2006, to reflect the reduced volume commitment for Fiscal Year 2007, due to the delay in shipping Applicable Waste under this agreement.

Other Conditions

1. Waste generators are solely responsible for registering Applicable Waste in a timely manner following its generation. Additional requirements related to registration of the waste may be stipulated in the Registration Form.
2. This Special Disposal Rate is entered by the State Budget and Control Board through its Executive Director pursuant to S.C. Code Ann. Section 48-46-40(A)(5).
3. The parties understand that statutory or regulatory constraints may make it impossible for South Carolina to accept any or all of the applicable waste specified under this agreement or other agreements. In the event that South Carolina is unable to accept the waste for disposal, then the exclusive remedy for generator is relief of any obligation to make payments for any waste not accepted for disposal. In the event that South Carolina, for any reason, is unable to accept waste from the Atlantic Compact, under the conditions set forth in 10 CFR 1800.13(h), then South Carolina shall be subject to the repayment of a pro-rata portion of Compact membership incentive payments, and interest, as described in that regulation.
4. Customer understands and adheres to the attached Policy on Disposal Site Access and Disposal Rates, January 2001, Revised July 2005, which is also posted on the www.barnwelldisposal.com web site.

Instructions

Registered Waste that is generated by Atlantic Compact generators prior to May 1, 2008, and received for disposal July 1, 2008, or after, is eligible for a Special Disposal Rate, as described herein. Waste must be registered within 60 days of its generation. Waste may be registered 60 days or more after its generation at South Carolina's option.

Waste that is "generated" is defined generally as material that is removed and isolated from other materials for purposes of disposal. The date waste is generated is generally the date that the waste is removed from its initial collection point and moved into a location whose purpose is the consolidation of waste prior to shipment for disposal or for treatment prior to disposal. This location may be, for example, a closet, a room, a separate building, or a specific area within a room or a storage facility off-site.

Disposal Rate

The disposal rate for all waste registered as Applicable Waste is 75 percent of the disposal rate that would be assessed for that waste, if the waste had been disposed in Fiscal Year 2007, under the FY2007 rate schedule or contract rate that would otherwise be applicable to the waste.

Option B Commitment Customers

Waste generators who have submitted Option B Volume Commitments for Fiscal Year 2007 may revise and re-submit those Volume Commitments to South Carolina, without penalty, not later than September 30, 2006, to reflect the reduced volume commitment for Fiscal Year 2007.

Other Conditions

The Disposal Rate under this Agreement for Applicable Waste does not apply to waste generated May 1, 2008, or after. That waste shall be subject to the prevailing disposal rates or contract rates applicable at that time.
