Reminder: When labels are received, the manufacturer is responsible for recording the energy efficient label number, serial number, HUD label number, and the retailer and location shipped to on the Label Disposition Report. A copy of the Label Disposition Report is then sent to the Energy Office.

For a manufactured home to meet South Carolina's standards for energy efficiency, the home must have the following:

- 1. Storm or double pane glass windows;
- 2. Insulated or storm doors;
- 3. A minimum thermal resistance rating of R-11 for walls, R-19 for floors, and R-30 for ceilings OR allowances in the energy efficiency levels for walls, floors, and ceilings, so long as the heat loss does not exceed that calculated using the R levels stated above. These heat loss calculations are based on the current edition of the American Society of Heating, Refrigeration, and Air-Conditioning Engineers (ASHRAE) Guide at the time of the home's manufacture.
