# Energy Label Project Phases

- Energy Label Design
  - What is the key information for the SC label
  - How is the Information presented on the label
- Administration
  - Who creates the label
  - Who manages the assessor/rater
- Training & Education Needs
  - Who needs training
  - What is critical to use/understand the label
- Pilot Program
  - Possible locations / participants

# Information Learned From State Energy Office Interviews

- SC Labeling Pilot Program Model
  - SC pathway similar to Oregon and Missouri labeling programs
  - SC Energy Office to be DOE HES Program Partner for labeling implementation
  - Labeling vendor to provide infrastructure to run labeling program, training for assessors and assist Energy Office in managing program
  - Adoption by local jurisdictions recommended as best pathway for effective implementation

# Labeling Vendors

- Earth Advantage
  - PEARL
  - Clearly Energy
- Interviews held with each potential labeling vendor
  - Follow up conversations held with EO in state where each vendor is already contracted
  - Scope of work and implementation approach discussed with each vendor

# Next Steps

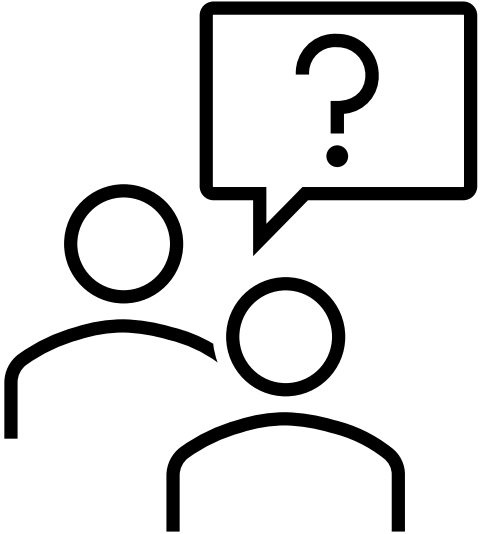
- Bring “Quick Start” Vendor Onboard
